Charity Quilts

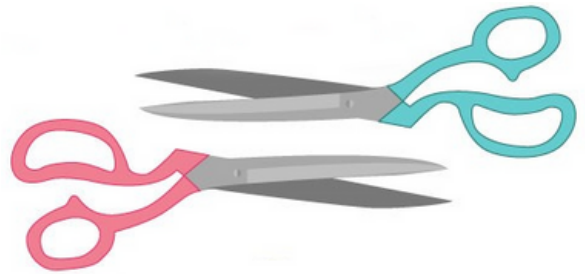
The Meals on Wheels Program wants to thank you all for the generous donation of over 90 placemats this year. They have and will continue to brighten the day for the people they serve in the community.
